Psalm 116

The verses are spoken antiphonally between the Pastor and Congregation.

P (Antiphon) Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of his saints.

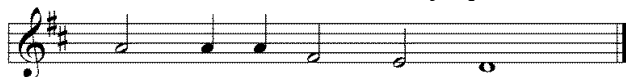
